PERMANENT WAVE chased the pace while three wide throughout, came under coaxing just past the five-sixteenths, was fully let out swinging for home, collared the leader in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and edged away being kept to task to the wire. GET ER UP stumbled slightly at the start, set the pace between rivals, felt pressure on the outside nearing the top of the lane and was called upon, responded well holding safely for the place while unable to keep up with the top one through the final eighth. STARSHIP GIRL hand urged from the gate when outrun early, came under a long drive while saving ground through the turn, angled out just past the three-sixteenths pole displaying a belated kick for show honors. BYE LOVE YOU broke out at the start and was corrected, raced three to four wide throughout, came under a ride nearing the head of the stretch while swinging four wide, kicked on mildly by tired foes in the lane. SUNDAY AT NIPPER'S prompted the pace inside, came under a drive approaching the quarter pole and steadily faded through the lane. SIBERIAN WILDCAT coaxed along chasing while in the two path in midpack, weakened in the lane. DADDY CAN reserved off the pace, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the quarter pole and offered no response.
