CONGO broke well, set the pace along the inside, came under encouragement spinning for home, drew clear under a drive through the lane, was taken in hand in the last few strides when the outcome was no longer in doubt. MAGICAL MYTH saved ground while under coaxing, came under further rousing just past the five-sixteenths, rallied with good energy through the furlong grounds to just get up for the place honors while never threatening the winner. EXPECTING CASH chased three wide throughout, was let out at the five-sixteenths, responded readily while no match for the top rival, held well to garner the show honors. CALL FIRST allowed to settle early on, availed of an opportunity to alter to the rail in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths and took it, saved ground through the far turn, coming under a ride just past the five-sixteenths, rallied mildly by tired rivals through the lane for the last major share. ASSURED VICTORY tracked the pace from the two path, was let out coming to the head of the lane, offered up a mild bid being out finished through the final sixteenth when beginning to tire. MAJESTIC HOPE reserved off the pace, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths and tired. SUPREME RULER broke in at the start and was corrected, raced three wide in both turns and offered no kick. QUICK RECOVERY crossed to the fence shortly after the start, saved ground throughout while being out run, was eased coming to the quarter pole.
