VICTORIOUS LEADER secured a forward position before departing the backstretch, sat poised in the three path, under some lightly hand urging to maintain interest. was let out a notch leaving the five-sixteenths marker and ranged up, got put to a drive heading for the top of the lane and quickly took over, drew out to his biggest advantage with an eighth to go, stayed well in front, kept to the task at hand. WHY ARGUE raced from off the rail on the turn, was already under urging coming three wide into the lane, altered course towards the inside soon afterwards for better racing room and finished willingly to garner the place. LITTLE DALE rode the rail, was well in hand during the later stages of the run around the turn, got mildly shuffled, mired behind foes prior to cutting the corner into the lane, with the rider eventually steadying, was taken outward until about six wide while proceeding through the furlong grounds, rallied well to grab the show. DABA DABA three wide nearing the end of the backstretch, bumped lightly with AMERICAN BUFFALO, came home belatedly en route for the last major check. DAN'S GOLD vied for the lead from the outside and gave way. FLO'S GREATNESS argued for control from the rail until the quarter pole before faltering. SHOTGUN CITY two wide and set down by the five-sixteenths pole, had no response. CHASIN THE CASH placed seven wide at the top of the lane, was outrun. AMERICAN BUFFALO in the four path at the time, made light contact with DABA DABA, folded. DADDY'S WILDCAT chased three wide and had little left turning for home.
