RED MINX contested the pace from between rivals, edged away to tuck along the inside coming to the five-sixteenths pole, got set down heading for home, facing a slew of pursuers, edged away, driving. LATIN TUDOR departed the backstretch three wide, vied for the lead as the widest of a threesome until a bit more halfway around the turn, got guided into the two path a short distance from the quarter pole, continued on well but had to settle for the place. WORLDLY CHARM took the inside route for most of the way down the backstretch racing amongst rivals, rankly fought against the bit and the rating hold being applied by the rider, failed to settle down despite getting checked nearing the end of the backstretch, tipped into the two path but continued to act rankly, got checked at the seven-sixteenths pole, racing between rivals at this juncture, kept pace throughout the run around the bend continuing to be firmly rated, was steadied for a third time, behind rivals heading for the quarter pole, was given some rein shortly afterwards, altered course over to an unobstructed rail passageway approaching the furlong marker, got called upon and failed to fire. IMAGE OF ANNA was briskly hand urged leaving the gate to secure a forward position, argued for the lead as the innermost of three until about halfway around the turn and faltered. COSTELA was yanked on left rein by the rider after breaking towards the outside, was placed along the rail past the half mile pole and stayed along it for most of the way around the bend, swung three wide into the stretch, failed to muster up a kick. NIGHT TIME SLIPPER broke to the outside, remained well off the inside proceeding down the backstretch, was stacked four wide entering the turn, worked her way closer to the inside by the five-sixteenths pole, came into the stretch and gave way.
