Footnotes

EA raced well reserved from off the inside, bided time behind foes throughout the run around the far turn, turned for home and availed of the opportunity to alter course towards the middle of the strip in upper stretch, settled into his best stride, accelerating towards the front runners, was intermittently put to a left hand whip, but after drawing alongside the leader, went by under confident hand urging to prove best. HIGH STAKES PLAYER assumed the role of stalker soon after the start, was let out a notch to apply more pressure on the pacesetter midpoint down the backstretch, crept up further still to race as a team, from the two path, with the leader around the far turn, fought his way to a slim advantage after entering the stretch, proved powerless to stave off the winner, but continued onward willingly to secure second. DAY OF DESTINY tracked the leader from the inside and lacked the needed response. SAGINAW prominently placed while three wide around both turns, flattened out. LUNAR FLEET vied for the lead from the inside, remained a prominent pace factor until midstretch then weakened. REGAL WARRIOR underwent a three wide journey and made no serious moves.
