Footnotes

RAYTESSA took up residence in the pocket soon after the start, appeared keen from there, requiring the pilot to take a good hold on the reins at several points to throttle down some of that eagerness during the opening half, acted more professionally upon reaching the second turn, squeezed into the two path just past the three-eighths pole, split rivals through narrow quarters about a sixteenth down the road to grab the lead, got called upon and lengthened away from upper to midstretch, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of his biggest advantage, felt the runner up's presence soon afterwards, reached the wire in time to preserve the decision. JACKIN MY STYLE was unhurried from off the inside, was forced to check when unintentionally impeded by FORTYDEUCE in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, lost valuable momentum and ground as a result, got going again and ducked over to the rail recently vacated by the winner, cut the corner into the lane, altered course outward in midstretch, came home with good energy under a steady diet of left handed stick work, but needed one more jump to nail the top one. CAMERON CANYON underwent a three wide journey, was under a drive making a challenge midway on the far turn, flattened out. MOVES LIKE JAGGER had a ground-saving trip, was taken in hand when affected by the incident in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, failed to reach a contending position. WAR ROMANCE raced well off the inside throughout, swung onto the overland route on the far turn to avoid contact with the stricken rival. ROYAL INMATE bobbed after the start, but made the front quickly nonetheless, set the pace from the inside, came under heavy pressure on the far turn and readily succumbed. FORTYDEUCE prompted the pacesetter from the outside, was pulled up on the far turn and vanned off.
