RISK A CHANCE allowed to settle early on, raced under reserve in the two path, swung three wide at the head of the lane when called upon, displayed a good kick taking command coming to the final sixteenth, edged clear from that point on under a drive. ALPHABET JAMERICA loosely tracked the pace maker while in hand, advanced steadily on that rival under her own courage, took command at the quarter pole, inched away with a furlong to go under very little encouragement, was confronted by the aforementioned rival as they approached the final sixteenth, was fully called upon, couldn't match strides with the top one while well safe for the place honors, a clear second best. SOCIAL STATEMENT chased three wide throughout, steadily improved position coming to the head of the lane, was put to a drive at that station, offered a mild bid for the show spot. FREUD'S NOTEBOOK coaxed along tracking the front from the rail, advanced on the front and came under a ride at the head of the stretch, stayed on through the lane while being out kicked for the top spots while clear for the last major share. MY UNBRIDLED STORM reserved at the rear, had a ground saving journey, was spirited up turning for home, angled out in the lane at the three-sixteenths for a clear lane and offered little. LYNDSSEA'S MISS EL raced three to four wide throughout and offered no kick. THOSE LION EYES hustled from the gate, set the pace while saving ground and under a hold, was let out when under pressure approaching the quarter pole and gave way.
