FALAAH patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, crept up to increase the pressure approaching the quarter pole, with the rider still holding something in reserve, took over and began to edge away during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds, was first cross-reined then switched over to a brisk hand ride by the rider, drew well clear of the others. STAR HARBOUR made the lead under his own power, showed the way from a slight distance off the rail, with the eventual winner making his presence felt all the while, had the pressure intensified as the top pair neared the head of the stretch, proved no match in the lane, then just held the place. BLACK PEN raced three wide, was set down at the five-sixteenths pole, missed out on place honors. WEE FREUDIAN coaxed tracking the front runner from the pocket, faltered. RAYNICK'S JET under a good hold between rivals on the turn, was under encouragement spinning into the stretch, had no response. TOO TOUGH JAKE pulled off the nearest opponent after coming in a step or two at the break, trailed throughout.
