GRIFFIN ROCK was rated in midpack while racing along the outside, continued along on the same scenario until halfway around the far turn, was given some rein and eagerly closed the gap, tipped three wide and challenged for the front as the widest of the three front runners, was asked for more once into upper stretch and gave it to arrive at the eighth pole as the new leader, added to the winning margin, kept to solid hand encouragement. EL DREAMER tracked the front runners from the pocket, angled outward entering the stretch, proved no match. HARVEST KING patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside in the initial stages, ranged up to increase his presence upon departing the backstretch, challenged for command from between rivals turning for home, never fully cleared to the lead, then was outfinished. PROMISED DESTINY outrun early, was placed four wide at the head of the stretch, lacked a solid late closing response. MUSIC MAN STAN spurred away from the others and tucked along the inside, showed the way, being rated along, was put to a stern test approaching the quarter pole and was set down, offered resistance for about a sixteenth before relinquishing and gave way. AWESOME BID three wide on the far turn, tired. THUNDERVILLE saved ground to no avail. STONE PICKER broke in the air, fought fiercely on the bit resisting the rating tactics being used by the rider proceeding towards the opening bend, settled down a bit early during the run around it, swung three wide into the backstretch, was not reaching out well for a good portion of the way towards the half mile pole, arrived at that station and was given some taps on the right shoulder along with a increase in the strength in the grip on the left rein, but seemingly refused to move closer to the rail, folded.
