PRINCESS OF SYLMAR was put to a firm hold soon after the start, raced towards the inside on the opening bend, had the rider take a peek back and seeing no impediment to him doing so, swung three wide into the backstretch, made her presence more pronounced soon afterwards in response to the dawdling opening split, continued to bide time, was given her cue and unleashed a three wide bid from the three-eighths pole that carried her to the front by the crest of the far turn, extended the margin from upper to midstretch, then doubled it, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. KELLI GOT FROSTY was rated along the outside while prompting the leader for much of the opening three-quarters, proved no match for the top one after turning for home, but was kept going well enough to preserve the place. LET ME ENTERTAIN U put to a snug hold a short distance out of the starting gate, saved ground on the opening bend, left the rail upon entering the backstretch, departed it from the four path, went on a little further then launched a run of her own just after the winner had began hers, failed to keep pace with that opponent, but rallied to get up for the show. KIMONO quickly cleared the field and tucked along the rail, got away with a rather pedestrian first split uncontested, set another rather ordinary one but now doing so with another twosome paying closer attention, came under heavy pressure coming to the five-sixteenths marker, succumbed to it and backed away. MARCELLINA D'ORO saved ground and was outrun.
