START IT UP broke to the outside, eventually bumping with TAKE THE ZEPPOE and forcing that one as well two others to the outside, moved up to assume a forward position, vied for command, the widest of three and under the most confident handling of the trio, turned for home with little separating the combatants, edged away to a narrow lead then got asked for run, maintained the advantage to the end, kept to a light drive. A PRETTYDIXIE tucked along the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, was asked for some run by the five-sixteenths pole, went on to cut the corner into the lane under a full drive, altered course to be outside the front runners halfway down the stretch, continued onward and closed in well on a winner not being asked for her best. THEPOWERSTHATBE chased the pace skirmish from along the outside, was put to some urging and gained ground readily late on the turn, spun into the stretch and maintained the move to rally for the show. TAKE THE ZEPPOLE bumped at the start, got carried inward by the wayward winner, with the rider checking shortly afterwards, raced from off the inside, entered the stretch having already been put to encouragement and finished well enough to earn the final major slice of the pot. CURLIN N TWIRLIN battled between foes until into the furlong grounds before backing away. GROUP THERAPY along the rail, argued for command with two others parked out in paths two and three respectively, was under a drive prior to reaching the quarter pole, kept up the fight for an additional furlong and gave way. LARA the last of three bothered to some degree from pressure originating from the inside and created by the top one, raced three wide and failed to reach a contending position. WILD CHILD got off to the same kind of rough beginning as did TAKE THE ZEPPOLE, dropped back to trail at a considerable distance in the early going, saved ground until upper stretch.
