DANEMEI was bumped after the start, raced close up along the inside, was steadied in traffic in upper stretch, found room, dug in gamely and got up late. IRVING'S RUN raced close up early, came wide for the drive and dug in gamely to the finish. QUICK AND EASY was bumped after the start, was outrun early, altered course in the stretch and finished well. VICTORIOUS AFFAIR raced close up outside, rallied three wide on the second turn and tired in the stretch. GOLD AND BLUE BOX raced wide and had no rally. SMART THINKER pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. UNBREELIEVABLE set the pace along the inside and tired. ROYAL LIVINGSTON broke down and was vanned off. BILDANS LAD stumbled badly at the start and lost his rider. Following a general Stewards' inquiry the result was declared official.
