FORTUNATE RUN within striking distance while taking the inside route, was forced to remain on hold approaching the head of the stretch, while searching for the best opportunity, took full advantage of a clear alleyway along the rail turning home, sneaked through and was roused to the lead by the time he hit the three-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, then increased the winning margin under a drive. HOPEFUL BOY pressed the pace from the outside, was outkicked by the top one during the stretch run, but dug in to preserve the place. TALK TO NICK rated three wide, was set down in upper stretch, finished willingly, only to fall short of taking second. U BOAT ALLEY made the lead under her own courage, showed the way until the top of the stretch, remained a prominent factor before tiring steadily during the final eighth. WHEELSAREOFFTHEBUS failed to menace. TURNPIKE TOKEN was no factor. TAPITS MAIN MAN saved ground to the quarter, was angled outward but had no rally.
