Footnotes

BIG BROWNIE away in good order, raced from off the inside, was asked for some run by the three-eighths pole, took some time before responding to that encouragement, turned for home three wide and gradually moved one path further to the outside in upper stretch, started to kick in with good energy during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds, came inward slightly as NICOLE'S MISS B was being carried outward, the latter primarily from the effects of left handed stick work being applied on SALTAMONTES, in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, was driven to the front in short order and edged away. LADY GRACENOTE unhurried in the initial stages, willingly picked up the pace from the two path around the turn, with the rider mildly hand urging her to maintain interest, turned from there into the stretch, but was tipped out one extra path shadowing the top one's movements at that juncture, was rallying willingly along a clear lane to the wire, had that passageway shut down tight by a pair of opponents approaching the sixteenth pole, forcing the rider to steady off heels, got going again and finished with good courage to garner the place. SALTAMONTES was hand urged to the front, set the first split under the watchful eye of NICOLE'S MISS EL, had that opponent drew alongside and initiate a head to head duel, just past the three-eighths pole, turned for home and continued to battle hard, began to drift outward departing the backstretch, came out more readily after the pilot switched over to a left handed stick, weakened late into the show slot. NICOLE'S MISS EL contently stalked the leader from the outside, ranged up to increase the pressure after entering the bend, raced as a team with the show horse, was still locked in battle when herded outward by SALTAMONTES with about a sixteenth to go, got outkicked thereafter. GUYANA PRINCESS off to a beat slowly, failed to reach a contending position taking a ground-saving journey. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run before the result was declared official. In addition, a claim of foul lodged by the rider of LADY GRACENOTE against the rider of BIG BROWNIE alleging interference in deep stretch was not allowed.
