MARQUET REBEL cocked his head sideways and got off a beat slowly after appearing to brush the right side of the starting, moved past rivals under his own power and secured a forward post, appeared eager during the run around the first turn, was allowed enough rein to take up position just off the pacesetter's hind quarters from along the outside, ranged up to confront that opponent upon reaching the far turn, sparred for a quarter of a mile, commencing from the seven-sixteenths pole before shaking free, felt the runner up's presence a short distance down the road, dug in stubbornly to turn back that rival's challenge. DUBAI GOLD underwent a three wide journey, closed in steadily throughout the stretch, wasn't able to reel in the winner, then was vanned off after the finish. SCIBELLI sped off to a comfortable early advantage, had the top one increase the pressure midway down the backstretch, felt yet more pressure from that rival entering the far turn, raced as a team with MARQUET REBEL from the seven-sixteenths pole until upper stretch before backing away. BIG POLK A DOT parked in the four path around each bend, had little left for the stretch drive. FRENCH TRANSITION swung four wide into the stretch but had no offering to render. MERLIN BAY saved ground until midway around the far turn, was outrun. PRINCE DUBAI placed five wide at the head of the stretch, was empty. FREGATA faded off a ground-saving journey.
