Footnotes

RACONTEUR allowed to settle early on, tracked the pace from the two path just in behind the front, came under a drive in the vicinity of the quarter pole, angled out one additional path at the three-sixteenths, rallied through the furlong grounds battling with a stubborn rival until the final few strides when able to begin to inch away to prevail. TWO SEVENTEEN under a firm hold, chased the pace while three wide, took command just past the five-sixteenths under very little urging, swung three wide at the quarter pole, was let out while angling in to the two path, fought well through the final eighth being headed in the final sixteenth in the final few strides while safe for the place. SUMMER SUNSET broke sharply, set the pace inside while saving ground throughout, came under pressure by the aforementioned rival near the five-sixteenths, succumbed the lead while under a drive swinging for home along the rail, stayed on well through the lane angling out at the sixteenth pole to just preserve the show over a rallying rival nearing the wire. HOLIDAY PROMISE rated off the pace in the two path, raced three wide in the turn, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths when availing of the opportunity to again race in the two path, found his best stride in the late stages just missing the show honors while well clear for the last major share. MONEY IN MOTION raced three to four wide in midpack, came under a prolonged drive from the three-eighths and lacked a late kick. ROMANCING THE GOLD raced three to four wide throughout, was asked near the five-sixteenths and offered little. MAYBE'S MASTER crossed to the rail shortly after the start, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths along the rail, made no late headway and tired. KEVIN SILVERLASPIA urged from the gate, pressed the pace from the two path for a half and gave way.
