Footnotes

CROSSBOW set the pace from the two path uncontested, was let out a notch while still safely clear at the head of the lane, increased his margin coming to eighth pole, held that advantage through the furlong grounds under light hand urging throughout. ADMIRAL PERRY chased the pace from the three path, came under a drive at the quarter pole, ran on with good energy, no match for the winner while just preserving the place from a fast closing rival along the rail. STARFORADAY saved ground throughout, had to pause in behind briefly near the five-sixteenths awaiting an opening, cut the corner into the stretch under a drive, rallied readily along the rail to just miss the place while no threat to the winner. SAM SPARKLE took the overland route through the turn under coaxing, swung four wide at the head of lane and was out kicked by the top three while garnering the last majors share. DE PRICE chased the pace inside, came under a ride at the head of the lane and weakened. EL GRAN SOL under urging from the start, chased the pace three wide and tired. TOGETHER INDY out run early, chased the front while racing wide, came under a drive at the head of the stretch, drifted out through the lane while offering no rally. ROGUE VICTORY allowed to settle, came under a prolonged drive from the three-eighths pole and gave no response.
