Footnotes

DEMON'S DEPUTY made contact with BUDDY JONES at the start, settled along the inside soon afterwards, tracked the front runners sitting the pocket trip, slipped to the outside at the five-sixteenths pole, kept going wider and wider until in the three path by the head of the stretch, drove his way to a clear advantage during the ensuing furlong, drew off, kept busy to the end. CROSS GATE put to some motivation near the right shoulder came out, eventually making sufficient contact with IMRELOADED and getting tuned slightly sideways, pressed the issue from the outside on the turn, ranged up and made his presence more pronounced prior to spinning into the lane and grabbed away the lead, failed to keep up with the winner once displaced but held well to secure second. ARTIST COLONY was reluctant to load, proceeded to duck in a couple of steps as the field was off and running, but was grabbed hold and pulled away from the nearest opponent in time to avoid any bumping incidents, held the lead for a few strides then fell back into midpack, tucked along the rail at the end of the backstretch and rode it all the way around the turn, felt a series of right handed shots from the right side cutting the corner into the lane, rallied to grab the show. IMRELOADED bumped after the start, chased three wide, and was through after going a half. EXCESS LIQUIDITY raced along the outside, was put to a prolonged drive, made no headway and tired. BUDDY JONES bumped at the start, race from off the inside, gave way. BAL TIC COAST lost his footing coming out of the gate, moved up to grab a slim advantage, argued to maintain it while saving ground, came under heavy pressure approaching the quarter pole, soon succumbed to it.
