MALACHITE forwardly placed nearing the end of the backstretch, sneaked his way over to the rail past the half mile pole, closed the gap during the run through the furlong grounds, entered the stretch and sat patiently off the inviting hole along the rail, made his move when it developed to the rider's liking by mid lane, slipped by the second place finisher took over then drew clear under good handling. BELLAMY STORM was rated near the two path vying for the lead, with the rider holding something back all the while, entered the stretch and got asked for run, was overhauled by the eventual winner along the exposed left flank in the vicinity of the eighth pole, then held on long enough to fend off the late-closing ERIK THE RED to preserve the place. ERIK THE RED driven five wide into upper stretch, came home with good belated energy only to miss out on the place. DR. CHASE came inward at the start and brushed with SUMMER SANDS, sat reserved from along the outside in the initial stages, rallied into contention from the quarter pole to midstretch, flattened out. BIG FOOT BEN urged on the turn, made no serious moves. YO BLUE disputed the pace three wide for a half before giving way. SUMMER SANDS made light contact with DR.CHASE after bobbling a bit at the start, darted to the inside and saved ground throughout thereafter, failed to get motivated with some light taps on the right shoulder midway down the backstretch, was put to strong urging nearing the stretch and remained under it to the end while nearly trailing at all times.
