**Footnotes**

GIVING ME FITZ sparred for command from along the the outside, poked a head down in front by midstretch, dug in with good determination to maintain it while drifting out. PROUD SIREN three wide departing the backstretch, was urged on the turn, mustered up a good kick, missed. AWESOME ISLAND tracked along the inside, flattened out in the final furlong. BAYSHORE BLAZE three wide entering the turn, was four wide exiting it, lacked the needed late response. STAY COMPOSED stumbled badly at the start, rushed up under light hand urging to procure a prominent placement, dueled with the top one until midstretch then gave way. SASSIDY off a beat slowly, would have been the last breaker if not for the troubled beginning for STAY COMPOSED, raced towards the two path and had no rally. SHES TUFF AS NAILS raced along the outside and displayed only brief foot. AZASECRET chased for a half before backing away. PRINCESS KATRINA had a wide journey for the opening half, had the rider use a snug hold on the left grip and give some taps on the right shoulder to counteract the mount's desire to come out, spun about four wide into lane, drifted inward after a few interspersed right handed shots and made no impact.
