WASHINGTON'S RULES got bumped just after the start, quickly tucked along the rail, raced sluggishly while proceeding down the homestretch, stayed along the inside route around the opening bend, was tipped into two path and drafted behind ROMANCING THE GOLD the rest of the way to the half mile pole, re tucked along the rail after the previously-mentioned foe chose not to do so, remained unhurried, started to pick up interest a few strides before arriving at the quarter pole, was angled outward slightly for the commencement of the stretch drive, made a minimal amount of progress at first, but began to close in more readily once past the eighth pole, was taken a bit wider and split rivals with about seventy yards to go, grabbed away the lead from TERMINUS and edged away. STREET FIGHT argued for control with TERMINUS, got asked for a response after that rival drew alongside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, surrendered the lead but kept in close proximity nonetheless, staged a mild comeback against a weakening rival to regain the place. TERMINUS sparred from the outside, got called upon spinning into the lead, forged his way to a narrow lead, weakened in the late stages and had to settle for the show. GRANDPA LEN tracked the front runners while saving ground, left the five-sixteenths pole under more solid hand urging than before reaching this station, angled to be outside turning for home, lacked the needed closing punch. ROMANCING THE GOLD made contact with rivals from both sides, with the one breaking to the right at the start, and with the one on the opposite side soon afterwards, raced from off the inside and had no rally. WAYWARD SAILOR bumped a couple of jumps after leaving the starting gate, underwent a three wide journey, folded. DATTT HAPPY broke inward, bumping with the nearest opponent and instigating a chain reaction of bumps that affected two others as well, raced three wide around both turns, drifted wider into the stretch while tiring.
