BEARURSA reserved while racing along the inside, was eased outward to enter the stretch between rivals, took off after the leader after being put to a light drive, gained command leaving the eighth pole and edged clear, never in need of being fully extended. JABBAR chased the leader during the initial half, took over the lead soon after entering the far turn, left the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, was unable to stave off the confidently-handled winner but continued on willingly to secure the place. HONEYMOON SUITE three wide around the second turn, displayed a mild rally to be along for show. IMALADYSTELLA was no factor. WISE CHOICE saved ground to no avail. IMTHEQUEENOFQUEENS carried out a bit by a rank KAFFIEND, settled in the back of the pack, was checked soon after entering the far turn, went out to the four path, was five wide at the top of the lane, and failed to muster up a solid stretch bid after being called upon. KAFFIEND was steadied after lunging at the break, was rank during the run leading up to the opening bend, took the overland thereafter and tired. HOOKIN THE GOODS set the pace towards the inside, faded after going three-quarters.
