### Footnotes

NO IMAGINATION sat well placed along the outside during the opening half, briefly ventured into the three path to scoot by a weakening rival before being placed two wide again, steadily ranged up, split rivals just past the five-sixteenths pole to continue the advance, responded well when given her cue in upper stretch, reached nearly even terms with an eighth to go, went by to take over and edged away under hand encouragement to the wire. SOO'S PURSE quickly established command and took up position in the two path, vied for the lead, under a firm hold, before edging clear coming to the half mile pole, continued on the front, with the rider keeping something in reserve throughout the run around the second bend, had the rider cast a furtive look back at the closest pursuers turning for home, was asked for run in upper stretch, felt the top one's presence approaching the furlong marker, gave in that one soon afterwards, but had more than enough left to be safely clear for place honors. HIS PRECIOUS LADY raced three wide around both turns, was asked for a response at the five-sixteenths pole and tired. BACK TO HURSTLAND took the inside route and faltered after turning for home. PRINCESS SUCREE strung out three wide on the first turn, ducked to the inside at the half mile, and steadily tired after completing three-quarters. PERSKY'S LOVE fought against the bit during the initial stages, sat well off the front runners while saving ground, angled outward approaching the head of the stretch, but lacked a solid closing punch. LEGIONS STAR off the rail, offered little. GLORIFIED GIRL forwardly placed outside, stopped after a half.
