Footnotes

COALTOWN LEGEND unhurried during the initial stages, was asked to pick up the pace soon after entering the turn, angled three wide for the stretch, run, took off in earnest when put to a strong drive, commencing from the three-sixteenths pole, gained ground rapidly with long strides, collared the leader in deep stretch and drew clear. WADI SUKI sat reserved between rivals, steadily advanced in the right direction from the seven-sixteenths pole, split rivals just past the five-sixteenths pole to continue the bid, rallied with good energy in the stretch but had to settle for the place. CALLMETONY off a beat slowly, rushed up into a forward position, was put to a snug hold once the goal was achieved, remained within striking distance, was given some rein at the three-eighths pole, turned for home under much stronger encouragement, fought his way to a narrow edge coming to the midstretch, dug in well, but yielded late. DEALING LUCKY well placed along the inside for a half, was angled outward but lacked the necessary stretch response. KARAKORUM ON BLACK underwent a three to four wide journey and had no kick. KILN CREEK sluggish down the backstretch, swung wide for the stretch drive, settled to be six wide at the head of the lane and improved position with a mild rally. SIX GUN SHERIFF vied for the lead off the inside and tired leaving the furlong grounds. TIMBER CRUISE fought for the lead along the inside until the eighth pole before backing off. CODY GROVE had a wide trip and folded.
