LUNAR VICTORY underwent a three wide journey, moved when ready to take on the front runners after leaving the half mile pole, overhauled each of them, under his own power, and edged away to a clear advantage, drew off, under a mild hand ride. RUFFINO contently tracked the front runners taking the inside route, vacated the rail as soon as the eventual winner took over the lead, felt the whip the initial time in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a hard drive after entering the stretch, but proved no match. MOST HAPPY FELLA established control soon after the start, set the early splits from the rail and with rider applying rating tactics, was put to a stern test approaching the seven-sixteenths pole, succumbed despite being asked for run at that juncture, bested the others for the show award. SOUTHBACHSANDY patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, with the pilot atop with a firm hold on the reins, moved up from between rivals to issue a challenge for command after reaching the far turn, wasn't up to that task and tired. MAKE NOTE saved ground, was urged along on the second turn, made no headway on the front runners. INNTHWEST raced along the outside, was asked for run on the far turn, failed to respond. TAP ATTACK three wide on the far turn, folded.
