Footnotes

DIGITAL JOE tracked the pace while in reserve in the two path, challenged the pacemaker coming to the five-sixteenths pole, took command when set down approaching the quarter pole, inched away drifting out in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker when under left handed stick work, drifted in nearing the wire in the last few jumps again the reaction to stick work this time on the right side, dug in to prevail nonetheless while kept well to task. HOOK AND LATERAL tracked the pace inside, was taken in hand briefly down the backside when shying away from a rival to his outside along the rail, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths, rallied readily through the furlong grounds, squeezed between foes late splitting them in the final few steps while all out and just missed. MR ROSENTHAL hustled to the front, set the pace inside while pressed, was confronted by the winner near the five-sixteenths, battled briefly before conceding the lead, came under further rousing turning for home, fought on through the lane along the rail holding well to the end well clear for show honors, was in tight and taken in hand in the last jump before the wire when the two aforementioned rivals drifted in due to right handed urging from both in the last steps. S. Z. MADISON coaxed along from the seven-sixteenths, continued under a long drive and bested the rest. CRESCENT MOON DR raced wide throughout and passed tired rivals in the lane. LA FESTA E DOMANI chased inside, offered little. ALL ZIPPED UP outrun early on, raced three to four wide through the turn and was never a menace. A USED GUN hustled from the gate, pressed the pace briefly, gave way. GUYANA PRESIDENT broke sharply, was out hustled thereafter, raced three to four wide and was never a factor. There was a Jockey's Objection by the rider of HOOK AND LATERAL against DIGITAL JOE alleging interference in the backstretch which was disallowed prior to the race being declared official. AS PER RULING AQ 24-2012 FROM NYSRWB DATED 04/07/12, S. Z. MADISON HAD BEEN DISQUALIFIED AND UNPLACED DUE TO POSITIVE TEST.
