NICOLE H secured the pocket after the break, contently tracked the pacesetter from there, raced with a firm hold on the reins being applied by the rider, lacking optimal options from the five-sixteenths pole until the quarter pole, found wiggle room to vacate the inside just prior to reaching the head of the stretch, turned for home, however, still lacking ideal racing room, moved up willingly and squeezed her way between rivals to grab the front in upper stretch, hand roused and feeling the stick on the left shoulder only, began to spurt away from that point and went on to increase the winning margin, ridden out. HONCHIS'N PONCHIS was guided over to the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, stayed there for about a furlong, angled back to the outside just past the five-sixteenths pole, got called upon for the stretch drive and finished with good energy to garner the place. GOLDEN MYSTERY was grabbed hold after stumbling at the start, stalked the pacesetter from the outside, closed in to issue a challenge coming to the quarter pole, kept up the pressure until past the furlong grounds, then weakened into the show slot. LOVE THAT DANCE placed three wide and set down at the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. STREAKER raced from off the inside, was put encouragement entering the stretch, failed to gain ground appreciably, was taken over to the rail with a sixteenth remaining, continued onward fairly evenly. CINCO DE MAYO MIO saved ground, was already being urged cutting the corner into the lane, altered course to the outside in midstretch, had no rally. WINNING IMAGE broke on top and remained clear of the others after being on the receiving end of some hand urging, darted over to the inside, came under intensified pressure late on the turn, was let out in response, but soon succumbed.
