DI'S TIME outrun early, rallied inside on the turn, split rivals in deep stretch and was driving under the wire. FLAMINGO WAY stumbled at the start, raced inside on the turn, angled out for the drive and finished gamely. T STORM unhurried early, raced wide and finished well from the outside. YOUTEBETTERBELIEVEIT unhurried early, came wide into the stretch and finished well. TROPICAL PUNCH chased the pace while three wide and had no rally. MISS THERMAL TECH raced close up inside, rallied along the rail turning for home but was steadied while lacking room along the inside in midstretch. CARLEAVILLE quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace into the stretch and gave way in the final furlong. GO AGAIN VALID chased the pace and tired after the opening half mile. SAGE FOX dropped back after the start and trailed the field throughout.
