SIR JOHN stalked along the backstretch, rallied four wide to challenge at the quarter pole, battled heads apart into deep stretch and prevailed under left hand urging. MUCH THE BEST set the pace under pressure along the rail into upper stretch, fought heads apart into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. WOODACRE was unhurried early, steadied briefly while taken in hand on the turn, advanced four wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. VALID SUM raced in traffic between horses for a good part of the way, angled three wide entering the stretch and rallied mildly. OSKAR HVAL raced in good position along the rail, waited briefly on the turn, rallied inside in midstretch and flattened out. NOW ACT pressed the pace between horses into midstretch and tired. STONE TURTLE steadied at the start and was never close thereafter. STREET CRED steadied and was shuffled back on the far turn and was never close thereafter.
