Footnotes

HURRICANE HEAT pressed in the two path, opened a clear lead in upper stretch and held sway under left hand urging. SHIP'S PIANO raced in midpack between horses, steadied in traffic midway on the turn then closed late in the two path. FIVE DEMON BAG raced in the three path just off the pace to the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch and weakened. FLASH OF VICTORY steadied between horses on the first turn, raced well back, steadied sharply nearing the quarter, swung six wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly. BEDFORD ARCH set the pace inside to the turn and tired. RED DEMON was shuffled back early, raced in midpack, steadied in traffic on the turn and lacked a further response. INDYMININE steadied sharply along the rail on the first turn, was outrun for a half, circled five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to menace. EXCEL steadied in traffic through the first turn, saved ground for five furlongs and gave way on the turn. Z'S PITCH steadied in tight nearing the first turn and was never close thereafter.
