STEPHEN'S RHYTHM'S well placed taking the inside route, slipped out to the two path turning for home, was roused to a clear advantage with a furlong remaining, then prevailed over a fast-closing HOLY TROUBLE, being kept busy to the end. HOLY TROUBLE raced four wide around the turn, and came home with good energy to make things interesting for the top one in the late stages. GATTINARA unhurried while three wide, finished well along the outside. NAVEDANO within range throughout, was outfinished during the stretch run. HAZAAM'S BACK chased the leader for a half before backing off. PERSIAN HONEY (BRZ) stumbled at the start, recovered in short order to establish command, showed the way for a half and folded. GELLHORN stumbled at the start, was outrun while racing along the inside, made a mild bid as she cut the corner turning for home, but flattened out.
