MEESE ROCKS quickly established command under her own courage, was comfortably rated in the two path while cutting the fractions, extended her advantage under hand encouragement after being let out a notch heading into the stretch, then maintained a safe winning margin while being shown the whip from the sixteenth pole to the wire. WHAT A PEAR pursued the winner four wide around the bend, proved to be no match, but continued on willingly during the stretch run to secure the place. SORORITY SISTER broke well, but dropped to the back of the pace in a hurry, was outrun during the initial half, angled outward in upper stretch and finding her best stride leaving the eighth pole, displayed a solid kick to be along for the show. AFLEET ALEXANDRA chased three wide, was asked for a response on the turn, but could make no headway on the winner. MOTOR CITY MAMA saved ground and lacked a solid response. SILVERCUP BABY between rivals, gave way after going five furlongs.
