Footnotes

TOBY'S CORNER the first to pop out of the starting gate, was grabbed hold of and eased back to the rear of the pack, contently rode the rail, under a good hold, until approaching the far turn, was gradually maneuvered outward, winding up in the four path by the three-eighths pole, turned for home a bit wider and having now been placed to some encouragement, locked horns with J J'S LUCKY TRAIN, raced on nearly terms from the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole, poked his head in front at this point and edged clear while being kept to the task at hand. J J'S LUCKY TRAIN made a three wide run to grab the early lead, was rated slightly off the inside while carving the pace, was put to encouragement from the three-eighths pole, when the pressure from the closest pursuers intensified, drifted three wide into the stretch, felt the top one's presence by the three-sixteenths pole, offered good resistance for an additional furlong before yielding, but continued onward with good courage for the place. PREACHINTOTHEDEVIL a bit uncomfortable between rivals soon after the start, staked the front runner from the outside, lacked the necessary response when called upon turning for home. ARTHUR'S TALE underwent a three to four wide journey, was put to a prolonged drive and tired after going six furlongs. RESCIND THE TRADE three wide around the first turn, was asked for some run to keep pace at the seven-sixteenths pole but wasn't up to the task.
