Footnotes

SHOW TRIAL took up position in midpack soon after the start, sat reserved, well in hand while racing along the outside until the quarter pole, took off in earnest when put to a drive heading into the stretch, drew alongside the front runners just past the eighth pole, hooked up in a duel with REDWOOD FEVER at the sixteenth pole, alternated on the front a couple of times with that opponent before getting the head down in time at the end to grab the decision. REDWOOD FEVER three wide around the opening bend, prompted the leader one path closer to the inside for the run around the subsequent bend, moved up to challenge for command heading for the quarter pole, struck the front at the furlong marker, but with the top one in hot pursuit, traded the lead with the top one throughout the final sixteenth, came out on the short end of the win photo in a gutsy try nonetheless. GAME TOKEN tracked the front runners from the inside, angled outward shortly before reaching the quarter pole, and was outkicked. THE CUFF SHOOTER rated in the two path, weakened steadily leaving the furlong grounds. ADIRONDACK WARRIOR improved position by mainly tired and weak ones during the stretch drive. SARATOGA COWBOY raced three wide around both turns and tired. EVEN FRISKY slipped off the inside during the run around the second bend, but failed to menace. BAI BAI DUBAI underwent a three to four wide journey and gave way. GIMMEANOTHERWINK cut the corner into the lane to no avail. ECRU EGRET strung well off

the inside on the opening bend, took the overland around the second turn and folded.
