ISN'T SHE GRAND set the pace while in hand, was let out a notch turning for home, drew away while in hand under very little urging a much the best winner. SMARTY BULL loosely chased the front from the two path, cut the corner into the lane under a drive, rallied up the rail with good energy to be clear for the place while never a threat to the winner. BLONDECAT settled inside under a hold, came under rousing approaching the quarter pole, angled out in the vicinity of the eighth pole rallying belatedly to just procure the show honors in the last jumps. LADY OF THE FOREST tracked the pace inside, came under a ride at the quarter pole and bid mildly being out kicked in the final jumps for the show spot. CATREIGN chased the pace three wide while prominent early, came under urging midway on the turn and tired. IBERIAN GATE leapt slightly at the break, pulled on the bit early resisting the hold by the rider, chased three wide, was set down at the head of the lane and offered no kick. BLUES HEIR chased from the overland route throughout and was no factor.
