Footnotes

FU PEGS BABY was unhurried for the opening half, picked up interest when placed three wide and asked for some run upon reaching the far turn, maintained the momentum entering the stretch, closed in relentlessly, racing as a team with the runner up in the late stages, to nail that rival in the last jump for the decision. EL DREAMER sat reserved for the opening six furlongs, picked up the pace late on the far turn and was gradually angled outward for the stretch drive, tipped into the four path for better racing clearance at the head of the stretch, gained readily on the leader leaving the furlong marker, with the top one tagging along at this stage directly to his outside, grabbed a short-lived advantage a short distance from the wire, dug in gamely, but got nipped. STONEMILL was squeezed back at the start, with the rider taking hold on the reins to avoid solid contact with each of the rivals breaking alongside him, underwent a three wide journey, steadily advanced into a forward position down the backstretch, under his own power, achieved the goal by the half mile pole, made a successful challenge for command leaving the three-eighths pole, spurred away to his biggest advantage from upper to midstretch, felt some heat from the first two finishers by the sixteenth pole, offered good resistance before relinquishing with less than forty yards remaining. CAROLINA CHANT departed the backstretch three wide, made a run to reach a contending position, could not sustain the move after entering the stretch and backed away. WIN THE DAY collided with MARMALADE SKY at the start, darted over to the inside soon afterwards, failed to reach a contending position. FALL INTO FAITH tracked from the inside, was under a firm hold in the early stages, fell back steadily before going a half. MAHFOUZ rated near the inside, readily succumbed when challenged on the second turn. COBALT RED prompted MAHFOUZ from the outside, was eased back after being displaced in the second spot by MARMALADE SKY midway down the backstretch, tucked along the inside and tired. MARMALADE SKY bumped with WIN THE DAY at the start, travelled in the three path on the opening bend, moved past COBALT RED to briefly assume the role of stalker, attended the pacesetter from the two path until near the three-eighths pole and gave way.
