SEE MORE SPIRIT was well placed in midpack for a half, made a rapid four wide move to take the lead nearing the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and held off TARGE under right hand urging. A claim of foul lodged by the rider of ALMIGHTY SILVER against the winner for interference on the turn was disallowed. TARGE was outrun in the two path to the turn, swung wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. BEBOB pressed the early pace from outside, was in tight battling between horses on the turn and finished willingly to gain a share. ALMIGHTY SILVER raced up close while three wide, lodged a mild bid between horses midway on the turn, steadied while unable to maintain his position approaching the quarter pole, angled out and lacked a late response. GREAT EMPEROR set the pace along the rail into upper stretch and tired. OVEREXTENDED steadied along the rail and was shuffled back early then never reached contention while drifting in the stretch.
