DRIVEN BY SOLAR was rated while stalking the leader from the outside, ranged up to the front while still not being asked for his best turning for home, was put to a stiff drive, commencing from the quarter pole, went head to head with KID FREUD during the run through the furlong grounds, shook free of that rival upon reaching the eighth pole, then drew off from that point while remaining under energetic handling. SIX FLINGS always inside, rallied into the second slot, and had enough left leaving the sixteenth pole to preserve it from SCORCH THE TORCH's late bid. SCORCH THE TORCH reserved off the inside, came home willingly, but fell short of grabbing place honors. EL BORRACHO unhurried during the opening half, showed a solid kick leaving the furlong marker. KID FREUD forwardly placed, got locked up in a stretch battle with the top one from the quarter pole to midstretch before weakening steadily thereafter. ESTIMATOR was no menace. ROMA DI NOTTE was outrun. FREUDIAN STORM set the pace towards the inside for a half and faded. JUSTIN P trailed.
