ZIO TONY positioned just off the inside, moved into a forward position under his own power down the backstretch, waited until reaching the three-eighths pole before beginning a second advancement, was set down to a hard drive, with the pacesetter within striking distance as the field headed into the stretch, made some progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, continued onward, closing in more readily once past the furlong grounds, wrested away the lead during the final seventy yards and edged clear under a vigorous hand ride to the wire. QUICK MONEY exploded out of the starting gate and had the lead in a flash, was deliberately kept in the two path, sauntering alone on the front end during the opening half, was asked for a response turning for home, reached the eighth pole still holding on to a comfortable advantage, tried to dig in as the top one drew nearer with every stride, got caught with about seventy yards to go, but was still good enough to be clearly second best. SCORCH THE TORCH chased the pacesetter from the outside, and proved no match. GUNPOWDER CREEK bumped hard with FORTY PRAYERS leaving the gate, was the only entrant to take the inside route during the running of the event, cut the corner into the lane and flattened out. FUGEDABOUDIT SANDY left the backstretch four wide, gradually worked his way into the two path by the quarter pole, failed to have a serious stretch offering. LORD JET five wide on the turn, was never a menace. TYMPANIC three wide at the half mile, was through after completing a half. FORTY PRAYERS bumped soundly at the break, trailed throughout.
