**Footnotes**

LIGHTS OUT LISA away in good order, spurted away to an open lead, despite fighting against the bit, acted more professionally entering the backstretch, drew out to a commanding lead during the run around the second bend, was set down to a hard drive, commencing from the top of the stretch and remained well in front at the wire. LUCK off to a sluggish start, was devoid of speed during the opening half, crept her way towards the rest of the pack when put to a prolonged drive, sustained the momentum turning for home and rallied with good energy to take the place. SPIRITUAL TUNE unhurried for a half, angled three wide into the stretch under encouragement and finished well enough to take the show. MAID TO WIN loosely tracked the front runner while taking the inside route, was asked to pick it up departing the three-eighths pole, got outkicked in the stretch. LADY APPLE saved ground, slipped outward on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and improved position by mainly weak and tired rivals. MINISTER'S FATE raced along the outside was no factor. PALACE MISTRESS three wide around the first turn, tired after going a half. CRANBERRY QUEEN was placed in the three path leaving the first turn, proceeded from there around the subsequent one, was roused from three-eighths pole, failed to make any significant gain on the top one and backed off. ELAINE'S PRIDE urged from the gate, was a forward factor off the inside for six furlongs and folded. SILLY STREET left the homestretch the initial time four wide, tucked into the three path by midpoint on the opening bend after being taken in hand and eased back a bit, continued to race wide and never

reached a contending position.
