BRUSHING UP, unhurried while outrun early, came wide approaching the stretch and stormed down the center of the strip and was up in the final yards. FIRE KING pressed the pace from the outside, took over and drew clear in the stretch then dug in determinedly but could not withstand the winner. CHRONICLE S., close up early under a stout hold, advanced inside on the second turn and finished gamely on the rail. GALLOPING GAEL, unhurried early, rallied four wide on the second turn, loomed boldly from the outside approaching the eighth pole then stayed on well but could not gain in the final furlong. WOULD'N'T WE ALL stumbled leaving the gate, set the pace under pressure from FIRE KING and weakened in the stretch. MR. SINATRA, close up inside early while in hand, had no response when roused. HOLZMEISTER showed speed from the outside while in hand, raced three wide on both turns and tired in the stretch.
