BE BULLISH was bumped at the start, was steadied after the start, was snatched up on the backstretch, dropped back, rallied extremely wide on the turn, finished fast outside and was going away at the finish. PIQUANTE CAT set the pace along the inside, took a sizeable advantage into deep stretch and managed to hold the place. THAT'SRIGHTOFFICER was outrun early, rallied into the stretch and was going well late. RUSSIAN SAGE was bumped at the start, chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. PEPERONI was bumped after the start, raced inside and had no rally. ANOTHER FOOSE chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. THE TRUFFLE MAN raced three wide and tired. RAYNICKS CAT raced four wide and tired.
