Footnotes

HACKLETON broke out a bit as the field was off and on its way, disputed the pace outside the runner up, drew directly abreast a short distance before reaching the quarter pole, was a little ways into the stretch run before asked for run himself, battled on nearly even terms the rest of the way and won the bob. ANCIENT ROME argued to maintain control with the top one, doing so while saving ground, was the first of the combatants to having the pilot call upon the mount for a response, this occurring with several jumps to go before the opening half was completed, turned for home with the pace dispute having become much more intensified, fought with vigor to the end, but got denied. SHOTGUN CITY was hustled leaving the starting gate to attain a forward position, tracked the embattled pair just up ahead from the inside for nearly a half, tipped outward to be two wide by the top of the lane and was asked for his best, altered course to be outside the front runners at the eighth pole, made steady progress on them but not enough to go by. VEE'S ACCOLADE was grabbed hold shying to the outside from slight pressure coming from HACKLETON at the start, raced at or near the inside for much of the way towards the half mile pole, was in the two path departing that station, commenced to go wider at the five-sixteenths pole until in the five path a furlong later, rallied to take the last major check. MONEY ONLY rode the rail for nearly a half, was under a drive entering the stretch, flattened out. CLASSIC R AND B underwent a three wide pursuit, folded. CHASING MOONLIGHT rated under a snug hold to the five-sixteenths pole, fanned four wide into the stretch, had no rally.
