GRAND TREASURE pressed the pace in the two path, lodged a bid to challenge on the turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch, dug in while coming in slightly inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear late. JOE CORRIGAN raced in good position along the rail for a good part of the trip, lacked room while boxed in leaving the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, split horses while gaining in upper stretch, moved back to the rail inside the furlong marker, moved inside GRAND TREASURE to threaten a sixteenth out, then steadied and angled back out in the late stages. Following a claim of foul by the rider of JOE CORRIGAN against the winner, GRAND TREASURE was disqualified from first and placed second for interference in deep stretch. LIVING OUT A DREAM steadied and angled out while hard to handle on the first turn, raced five wide along the backstretch, lodged an outside move to threaten on the turn and weakened late. SHOT GUN HOLIDAY raced in midpack between horses for most of the way and lacked a late response. TOP LEADER saved ground on the turn, gained in upper stretch and flattened out. PRINCE DUBAI steadied along the rail on the first turn and was never close thereafter. COALTOWN LEGEND steadied at the start, raced behind horses to the turn, angled five wide and tired. ODOR FREE set the pace inside to the turn and gave way.
