MARK IT MAN contested the pace down the backstretch, from the outside, and under his own power, kicked away from the field during the later stages of the run around the bend, got asked for a response once settled into upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of a comfortable lead and safely maintained most of it to prove best. CHIEF WILD EAGLE between foes departing the backstretch, made a four wide run from the five-sixteenths pole, rallied willingly enough down the lane to grab the place. KID WANDO was put in tight quarters as HOWIE AND THE CAT was making his way over to the inside nearing the half mile pole, forcing the rider to eventually steady off heels, saved ground around the turn and got out finished. COTTONPICKINWABBIT swung five wide into upper stretch and displayed a mild response to improve position. HOWIE AND THE CAT vied for the lead from the inside for almost a half, then faltered. TAP CHAP took the inside route, was forced to steady when caught close behind another rival in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, failed to reach a contending position. JOHNNY JADE out hustled leaving the gate, underwent a three wide pursuit, folded. TAX RETURN well off the inside, tired.
