Footnotes

COALTOWN LEGEND unhurried for nearly a half, picked up the pace late on the turn, angled into the lane to be five wide at the head of the stretch, charged the track, gained readily on the front runners despite drifting out and got up late for the decision. BOLD DEED tracked the pacesetter from near the inside for the initial half, slipped into the two path approaching the quarter pole, was moving well when forced to alter course off heels in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, came home with good energy to secure second. JUPITER TRIO was guided over to the inside soon after the start, saved ground thereafter, unleashed a good rail rally for the show. WISE STOP argued for control, came under a two-fold attack coming to the quarter pole, held his ground with good determination during the next furlong, succumbed to the pressure soon afterwards and steadily weakened. PREMIUM WINE issued a bid from the three path at the quarter pole, kept up the pressure until the eighth pole before flattening out. PRECIOUS METAL came three wide into the lane, lacked the needed response. WON GREAT CLASSIC was grabbed hold after coming inward a step or two at the break, patiently stalked the leader from the outside in the early stages, raced together with PREMIUM WINE towards WISE STOP upon reaching the turn, challenged in earnest from between rivals after going a half, failed to sustain the bid and backed away. FULTON STREET three wide on the turn, tired.
