Footnotes

WORTH A BUCK settled tracking the pace while three wide, angled in to the two path near the three-eighths when the pace maker stopped, assumed the front nearing the five-sixteenths, was set down at the quarter pole, drew off readily through the lane under light hand urging, was geared down in the last seventy yards a much the best winner. CON THE CAT saved ground throughout, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, responded with a good kick, no match for the aforementioned rival while clearly second best. PATENT PENDING TOM allowed to settle early on, saved ground until the three-eighths when angled out by tiring foes, swung out one additional path at the head of the lane to be five wide and came home with late energy for the show. JAZZBO tracked the pace from the two path under restraint, was under coaxing in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch under a full ride, held on well through the initial portion of the stretch, flattened out late while garnering the last major share. PURGE BIRD reserved off the pace while chasing wide, angled to the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenth while already under a drive that commenced at the three-eighths, improved position into prominence by the quarter pole, couldn't sustain the bid weakening in the late stages. GRAMERCY rated off the pace, chased inside, offered no response when called upon midway on the turn. LIME ZEST lost his footing at the start, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths, raced four wide through the far turn and tired. CALL THE GENERAL set the pace inside under a hold for a half and stopped.
