**Footnotes**

STAR OF NEW YORK raced three wide around both turns, dropped back slightly early down the backstretch, while rating kindly, remained on reserve until late on the far turn, picking up interest as the field headed into upper stretch, forged to the front making his way to the eighth pole, then kicked clear, kept busy to the end. CRIBNOTE three wide nearing the end of the homestretch, worked out an early tuck into the two path during the run around the first turn, contently stalked the pacesetter for the initial six furlongs, moved up when let out a notch to increase the pressure coming to the quarter pole, entered the stretch, latched on to the leader's outside, had the eventual winner arrive on the scene soon afterwards, failed to keep pace with the top one during the last eighth but continued on willingly to secure second. COSMIC KING placed in the three path departing the backstretch, came home with good energy to gain the show. CRUSHING saved ground until the quarter pole, needed more. NACHO SAINT showed the way, rated along the inside until the quarter pole, was put to the test at that station, succumbed to the pressure and weakened steadily once past the eighth pole. COLOSSAL GIFT made contact with STEEL BRIDGE leaving the starting gate, was put to a firm hold by the rider for almost a half, tracking the front runners from along the rail, was angled outward in upper stretch, came up empty. STEEL BRIDGE got bumped at the start, took the inside route, was under a drive entering the stretch, couldn't muster up a kick. SMALL TOWN TALK raced along the outside, failed to respond when called upon at the five-sixteenths pole.
