TWO MORE JACS three wide in pursuit in hand in close aim of the front, got asked nearing the quarter pole and took over the front straightening for home, drew clear under a drive kept to task. KELTIC FIGHTER chased the pace along the inside in aim of the front, came under urging three furlongs out, angled four to five wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the place. CHIEF SCOUT hustled from the start, chased two to three wide from mid pack under a ride from the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick to just garner the show. GINGER'S JOE three to four wide in pursuit of the front, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, kept on through the stretch but was out kicked while just preserving the last major share. JOE ALAN cut the pace just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner headed for command into upper stretch, stayed on to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. CRAQUI three to four wide in mid pack, came under prolonged encouragement from the seven-sixteenths, spun four to five wide into upper stretch, improved position in the late stages while unable to make an impact for a minor share. HARLEY just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out and passed tired rivals in the stretch. WOBURN hustled from the start, chased from just off the pace while taking the overland route through the turn and weakened in the stretch. INDIGENE CHARM chased three wide from towards the rear pushed along from midway on the turn and made no impact. ANTONE SUAVEY hustled at the start, got coaxed along in pursuit while three wide in mid pack, angled six wide into upper

stretch and tired. LIGHT OF MERCY three to four wide throughout, came under urging midway on the turn and trailed.
