Footnotes

HOT RENDEZVOUS raced three wide on the far turn, fanned eight wide, the widest of all into upper stretch, got straightened away and arrived at the eighth pole having setting into her best stride, outkicked the the entire bunch to earn the decision. ALIANA shied outward a bit at the start, raced two wide for nearly the entire way around the turn, swung seven wide into the stretch, displayed good energy to secure second. SUPERIOR SARAH gave chase from being two wide on the turn, bumped lightly with DARLING BRIDEZILLA taking the five path for entrance into the stretch, came in shortly afterwards, carrying the aforementioned rival inward, and leading a contending EYES OF MIDAS to get checked and into losing all interest, continued to come inward racing towards the sixteenth pole, carrying MAKE THE MOMENT in the direction of the rail enough to bump with PEGASUS DIAMOND, continued to rally and got the show award. MAKE THE MOMENT saved ground for a half, picked up ground readily during the later stages of the run around the bend, joined up even close to a tightly-bunched up group racing from upper to midstretch, moved inward from pressure coming from an errant foe nearing the sixteenth pole, making contact with PEGASUS DIAMOND at that station, held on willingly for the last major check. DARLING BRIDEZILLA three wide entering the turn, worked out a tuck into the two path by its midway point, picked up interest when asked to and proceeded to swing four wide into the stretch, leaning upon and bumping lightly with SUPERIOR SARAH while doing so, had that foe come in soon afterwards and got bumped again, much harder this time, was carried inward afterwards by the same opponent sufficiently to pinch back EYES OF MIDAS, made up no ground thereafter. PEGASUS DIAMOND started the run around the bend four wide, but concluded it one path to the rail, got set down for the drive home, forged his way to the lead during the next furlong, but with rest of the pack still well in the hunt, proved powerless to match speed with the winner, but not before bumping with MAKE THE MOMENT with about a sixteenth to go. MADRE DITUTTICAPI prompted the pace two wide, challenged from between rivals for a furlong after the half was completed before backing away. EYES OF MIDAS tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, got eased off it for the stretch run, was pinched back and eventually checked at the eighth pole. TALENT N PASSION showed the way from the inside, yielded to heavy pressure travelling through the furlong grounds and gave way.
